If You Break Down or Get Stranded

- Remain with your vehicle if safe
- Use hazard lights and cones if available
- Conserve phone battery and water
- Use offline maps or GPS apps that work offline

- Contact roadside assistance if possible

Tips for Remote Areas

- Travel with water, snacks, and layers
- Share your route and expected return time with someone
- Avoid driving after dark in unfamiliar or unpaved areas
